Update on redevelopment.

The second stage of the redevelopment of the Gardens is now complete. New paths have been installed, along with seats and a

drinking fountain.
In addition, this year we can expect the installation of dripline irrigation around all the trees for summer. We are also expecting the



replacement of twenty trees that have been lost to the gardens in recent years and the restoration of planting along the 'straight six'. This will make a big difference to reducing wind and increasing shade during summer. Finally, council will be shortly be installing interpretative signage in the Gardens.



Hopefully this will increase the local community's understanding of the history Gardens. All in all, things are looking up. Spring has arrived and the Gardens are worth a visit.
