The state of the Gardens

As you'll see when you visit, the Gardens are looking wonderful - even in the height of a hot summer largely due to the hard work of the two council gardeners Camillo and Skye and the regular supply of water from the newly-installed watering system.



Council slow to implement Management Plan

In November Brimbank Council accepted the draft Management Plan, but we are yet to see any implementation of its recommendations, including the convening of the Strategic Management Group, the first step in getting the plan underway. We are currently waiting for Council to respond to a number of our concerns re tree health, inappropriate access to the Gardens by vehicles, and progress on Council plans for curvilinear paths to be constructed within the Gardens. We also await a response regarding when the vehicle crossing at the south corner of the bowling green area would be removed and replaced by new kerb to deter vehicle access to the Gardens at this point, as stated in the Management Plan.

News from Selwyn Park

Nearby to the Gardens, west within the neighbourhood of Albion, is the historic Selwyn Park. One of the centrepieces of Selwyn Park is the Eco-Living Community House and Community Gardens.
